

# Housing and Employment Resources for Veterans



Sheppard Pratt offers housing and employment solutions for veterans, who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, thanks to support from the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), the Department of Labor, and other partners.

## Services can include

- Housing and housing assistance
- Job training and employment opportunities
- Connection with legal assistance
- On-site and virtual mental health services and referrals to health care
- Childcare support and transportation assistance

## Our Programs

### Supportive Services for Veterans Families (SSVF)

Through SSVF, we help veterans and their families secure permanent housing. SSVF provides short-term case management to link families to housing benefits and sometimes provides temporary financial assistance with housing or moving expenses.

#### Eligible Veterans:

- At least one day of active military service
- Discharge other than dishonorable or bad conduct discharge due to General Court Martial
- Very low income
- Must be at risk of becoming homeless OR currently homeless

### Homeless Veteran Reintegration Program (HVRP)

HVRP helps veterans get meaningful employment

through certification programs, training, and job placement. We collaborate with public and private partners to provide supportive services and access to housing.

#### Eligible Veterans:

- At least one day of active military service
- Discharge other than dishonorable
- At risk of becoming homeless in the next 60 days OR currently homeless

### North Point Veterans Program: Housing Program for Homeless Veterans

North Point Veterans Program is a clinically intensive transitional housing program for homeless male veterans with a mental health and/or substance use disorder diagnosis. We provide employment support, financial counseling, help securing benefits, mental health and recovery-oriented services, and more.
