### Grilling/Fire Pit Policy

Summer is well on it's way!

Here is a reminder of our policies regarding grills and firepits:

Gas and charcoal grills may only be used in accordance with local safety codes and regulations. Charcoal grills must be at least 15 feet from any combustible structure.

The use of portable outdoor fire pits is allowed, only on cement/asphalt in the front of your house and 15 feet away from any structure.

### Maintenance

During this time, we are only responding to Urgent and Emergency Work Orders. All routine work orders will be addressed as soon as we get the all-clear that it is safe to do so.
