Lawn Maintenance Rules

With an abundance of rain we have gotten this summer, many back lawns are looking extra lengthy!

Rules

Lawns should be mowed and trimmed at a height between 2 ½ to 4 inches. To ensure that your lawn continues to stay green and healthy it is necessary that you water your lawn every 2-3 days depending on weather conditions.

Failure to properly maintain your lawn will result in Antelope Ridge utilizing a private contractor to cut your lawn at your expense.
