Trash Cans & Bulk Trash Pickup

Please keep in mind the following in regards to trash pickup and your trash cans:

- Trash cans must be brought back up to the home within 24 hours of trash pickup.
- Bulk pickup is the **FIRST** Monday of each month. Any bulk trash left outside during any other time of the month will result in Antelope Ridge removing that trash and a charge will be assessed to your ledger.
- During bulk pickup, you may set out anything besides tires and appliances. Those items will require you to make other arrangements for removal.
