Snow Removal

For the safety of all, residents are required to remove any accumulation of snow / ice on the exterior stairs, walkways and driveways of their homes in a timely manner. In the event of an emergency, it is imperative that access is available for emergency services and for the safety of residents. Residents are responsible for removing snow within 50 feet in any direction from their home.

Grills

The use charcoal/live coal barbecue grills on wooden decks is prohibited and must be used a minimum of 15 feet away from any structure. Fuel bottles (propane) from the gas-fired grills (attached or unattached) may be stored inside the garage. Do not store these bottles inside the structure. All grills may be stored in garages, on porches, decks, balconies and patios, provided the charcoal is completely extinguished or the gas fire is out and the propane is turned off.
