

Helpful Information

- ⇒ **Office Hours:** Monday-Friday 9 AM—5 PM
- ⇒ **Trash Service** – Bagged and tied trash must be curbside between 7am—9am Monday-Friday, except holidays. Do not put trash out over night. No heavy bags or Walmart bags. Use kitchen size only. Boxes must be broken down or won't be picked up.
- ⇒ **Non-Smoking Community** – Smoking is NOT permitted anywhere inside our gates (which includes cottages, club-houses, or common areas. If you do smoke outside the community, please pick up and dispose your cigarette butts properly. Your guests must also follow these rules.
- ⇒ **No Feeding**—Feeding ducks or geese is prohibited. If you have a bird feeder, be sure it sits up high enough where the ducks/geese can't reach it. Bird feeders also attract rodents.
- ⇒ **Pet Policy**—Pet owners are required to pick up after their pets on their own yards AND throughout the property as they walk their dogs. Proper disposal requires in a tied bag in your own trash or a dumpster on property. Do not leave it for someone else to clean up or throw it in the pond. All pets are to be on leashes when walking throughout the property. Please carry a poop bag or two at all times with your pet.
