Reminders Regarding Your Furry Family Members

Leashes - Your animals MUST be on leashes in all areas of Harbor Heights with the exception of inside your home. **When using a retractable leash, be mindful of keeping your animal within a few feet of you at most, not allowing the leash to become a tripping hazard to your neighbors.**

Potty Talk - Please remember to throw your dog waste bags away *OUTSIDE* before you come into the building. ***Outside of our building on the floor, inside the garbage cans on floors 1, 2, and 3 are not acceptable places.*** If your dog uses the outdoor pad on floor 3, throw the bags away outside on floor 3. **Please do not allow pets to potty in parking garage. Please do not leave pet waste on the sidewalks or flower beds outside of our entrances.**

Pet waste violations are subject to \$50 fines, per incident.

DID YOU KNOW?




IGNORE THE HYPE, DON'T FLUSH THE WIPES

Did you know that it is not safe to flush “flushable” wipes even though the word “flushable” is on the label, there is no industry-regulated criterion to determine what does or doesn't make a wipe flushable. “Flushable” wipes break down very slowly and can cause a massive clog in the pipes and septic system. In larger commercial and municipal systems, flushable wipes bind with other debris and form massive clogs, cause overflow, and reduce the flow and filtration capabilities of the wastewater system.

Always use cold water when running your garbage disposal. It helps solidify grease, preventing jams.

Avoid putting grease, fat, uncooked fat trimmings, potato peels, banana skins, broccoli, celery, corn, eggshells, coffee grounds, rice, pasta, and bones down the disposal, as they can cause damage, jams, or clogs.

To freshen up your disposal, try feeding citrus (lemons, limes, oranges) into it with warm (not hot) running water.


