

HOME CARE

STAINLESS STEEL SURFACES

Do not use scouring pads, harsh cleaners, steel wool pads, abrasive wash cloths or paper towels. Do clean your stainless steel with commercially approved products. Use a soft, clean cloth and wipe in the direction of the stainless-steel grain.

FLOORING

Never allow liquid to stand on flooring. To avoid dirt build up that can scratch and damage floors, sweep, dust, or vacuum regularly. Do not wash or wet mop the floor with soap, water, oil-soap detergent, or any other liquid cleaning material. Moisture can cause warping, joint-line separation, and swelling. Use cleaning products recommended for laminate flooring. Do not use bleach, abrasive cleaners, or any buffing or polishing machine.

COUNTERTOP

Use cutting boards and do not place hot items on countertop, as quartz is not immune to heat damage or scratches. Do not use harsh cleaners like bleach, wax, polish, or any sealants. Quartz is a smooth surface, without these applicants. Glass and surface cleaners are preferred.

WASHER AND DRYER

Use only High Efficiency detergents. The package will be marked “HE” or “High Efficiency.” Low water washing creates excessive suds with a non-HE detergent. Ensure your dryer’s lint traps are clean at all times to avoid overheating.

PATIOS AND BALCONIES

Please be courteous to neighbors and do not sweep debris over the side, power wash or hose down your patio, as this can cause damage.
