Get Started, it's Easy!

Use the information on the flyer to learn what you can do and what items can be recycled.

RECYCLING PREPARATION

- Empty bottles and containers.
- All materials may be mixed together.
- Leave lids on containers.
- Rinse all recyclables free of food residue.
- Flatten cardboard and paperboard boxes.
- NO disposable cups, plates or tableware.
- NO Plastic bags!

Simply place **recyclable** items directly in the blue bin

Other Recycling items include:

Beverage cartons, aseptic packaging and chipboard.

Carrier stock packaging such as food and beverage boxes.

Plastic bottles and containers made from #1 - #5 and #7 plastic resin.

plastic wrap, plastic products
without chasing arrow
symbol

Other Items

Expanded foam, reusable
bottles (nalgene or baby
bottles), clear polystyrene or
styrofoam (#6 plastic),
landscape waste

Toss your tied trash bag down the chute!
