LEED Checklist




The Checklist is divided into the following categories. There are 110 points available.

- Sustainable Sites
- Water Efficiency
- Energy and Atmosphere
- Materials and Resources
- Indoor Environmental Quality
- Innovation
- Regional Priority

HERS/ENERGY STAR Checklists

Builders are required to evaluate the thermal enclosure to ensure an energy efficient home and the durability risks and to minimize risks related to energy, moisture/mold and air quality.
