

Fair Housing Federal and Illinois State Protected Classes

In Illinois, it is unlawful for a housing provider to discriminate against a current or prospective tenant based on:

Federal Protected Classes:

- 1. Race
- 2. Color
- 3. National Origin
- 4. Religion
- 5. Sex
- 6. Familial Status (i.e., children)
- 7. Disability

Illinois State Protected Classes:

- 1. Marital Status
- 2. Citizenship Status
- 3. Military and Veteran Status
- 4. Unfavorable Military Discharge
- 5. Arrest Record
- 6. Victims of Domestic Violence
- 7. Status as being under an order of protection
- 8. Lack of permanent address or using the mailing address of a shelter or social service provider
- 9. Gender Identity
- 10. Sexual Orientation
- 11. Age (40 or older)
- 12. Genetic Information
