## POOL AND SPA RULES

Please shower before entering pool or spa – Please do not use soap, shampoo, oils or lotions before using the pool or spa.

When these products are detected in the water, the pool and spa will automatically be **CLOSED** for a mandatory 72 hours, per San Mateo Health Code, in order to re-sanitize.

### 1) **WARNING: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY!**

- 2) All persons using pool and spa do so at their own risk.
- 3) Residents shall assume full responsibility while using the swimming pool, and spa, and shall be responsible for the actions and conduct of their guests.
- 4) Persons under the age of 14 should not use pool or recreational facilities without adult resident in attendance.
- 5) **No alcohol, no food, no smoking, and no radios (or electrical devices) allowed in pool area or anywhere in the common areas.**
- 6) Pool and Common Area Facilities are open from 8:30 am to 7:00 pm.
- 7) **Pool is for Residents.** Guests only permitted with an adult resident present.
- 8) “Adult Residents must accompany guests” and stay with them at all times.
- 9) Pool guest limit is no more than 4 guests per household.
- 10) Residents are responsible for their guests’ conduct.
- 11) Residents must not give pool or common area key to anyone.
- 12) Running is not permitted in pool area.
- 13) **NO DIVING** – No rough housing or unsafe conduct around pool area.
- 14) **No climbing on pool handrails. No climbing on the pool fence or misusing furniture. Pool furniture does not belong in the pool – please respect our pool furniture and equipment.**
- 15) **Pool plastic ring and life saving devices are to be used for emergencies – NOT FOR PLAY.**
- 16) **No pets are allowed in pool or spa areas.**
- 17) **No skateboards – No bicycles – No bats and balls are allowed inside pool area.**
- 18) Those wearing long hair must wear bathing caps.
- 19) When wet, slippers and towels must be used before entering building
- 20) Glass is not permitted in or around the pool area.
- 21) Maximum pool area capacity of 25 persons.

The use of the pool and recreational common area facilities by guests is a privilege and may be revoked if Residents, or their guests, abuse the privilege by failing to act reasonably and in accordance with Park Rules and Regulations.
