



# Getting between Catamount Run and UVM Campus

Market Street has two GMT bus stops: Garden Street & Allard Square

These stops are served by the #1 and #11.

Students living at Catamount Run are eligible for a **Commuter Evening Permit (restricted 9:00 AM - 1:00PM)**

This permit allows parking in the Gutterson Garage and Catamount West Lots M-F before 9:00am or after 1:00pm and any employee lot after 3:30pm.



Only 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year medical students qualify for a **Commuter Yellow Permit**.

This permit allows for parking in the Beaumont Lot (overflow in Jeffords).

Second-to-third year students will be notified in Feb/March and offered the opportunity to purchase their permit at a prorated cost.
