

605 CONCORD: NEARBY TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS

Thanks for choosing to live at 605 Concord! One of the many benefits of this location is the range of transportation options available right in your neighborhood. The following is a summary of those options, with some links to help get you on the move in Cambridge! Refer also to the attached transportation map, which shows public transit lines in the 605 Concord area.

MBTA Red Line Subway at Alewife Station is just a 10-minute walk along Alewife Brook Parkway. Here's a link to the MBTA Red Line subway schedule: <https://www.mbta.com/schedules/Red/line>

MBTA Buses direct to Harvard Square are available at the bus stop just across Concord Ave., with bus routes #74 (weekdays) and #78 (weekdays and weekends) passing by every 15-30 minutes. Here's a link to the MBTA bus schedules: <https://www.mbta.com/schedules/bus>
