A Desert Holiday—Some of the best things to do in December

One of the most unique holiday events in the Valley happens at the **Desert Botanical Gardens** at the annual <u>Las Noches de las Luminarias</u>. Thousands of glowing lights are set out along the garden pathways, turning the grounds into a wonderland of light and shadow. Strolling musicians, hot apple cider, and gourmet bites only add to the wonder of it all.



Alice Cooper's Christmas Pudding has become one of Phoenix's coolest holiday traditions. The rock and roll spectacle is hosted by Phoenix native and legendary shock rocker Alice Cooper, who brings together a group of friends every year to put on a holiday-themed rock and roll show. Proceeds from Alice Cooper's Annual Christmas Pudding benefit Solid Rock and the Rock Teen Center, Cooper's faith based charitable groups dedicated to helping local at-risk teens avoid the dangers of gang violence drug abuse and other pitfalls. Past performers have included KISS, Johnny Depp, Joan Jett and other rock legends. The line-up is different every year and there are always a few surprises. Grab tickets early. This event tends to sell out.

Both kids and adults will love exploring the various animal-themed displays. Hot chocolate, apple cider and other holiday snacks are available at kiosks located throughout the zoo.



Cityskate Ice Rink—For another winter wonderland in the desert, head to downtown Phoenix for the annual CitySkate Ice Rink at the CityScape shopping, dinning and entertainment complex. Strap on your ice skates and take a spin around the ice rink, then enjoy holiday cookies and listen to holiday carolers. Want to get your picture taken with Santa Claus? Saint Nick himself stops by every Saturday and Sunday from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Day Trip to Jerome

Jerome is a former copper mining town that's been transformed into a quaint and artsy getaway that boasts old time-y saloons, Victorian facades and plenty of Wild West history. With mild temperatures, cozy restaurants and winding hillsides, it's a perfect winter escape from harsher weather and snow.

Once filled with rowdy bars and treasure hunters looking to make their fortunes, Jerome nearly nbecame a ghost town when the mining industry withered away. The last mines closed after the Great Depression and Jerome almost disappeared off the map. However, its residents and artists saved this Northern Arizona town from oblivion. Today, Jerome's winding streets are lined with restored buildings, quirky boutiques with local handicrafts, wineries, and saloons.

Winter is a wonderful time to explore Jerome- climbing up its rolling hills is a lot more doable on a mild, sunny day. This small town enjoys winter temperatures that reach highs of in the low 50s and just a few days of light rainfall each month.

While you're in town, shop for some local art at Jerome Artists Cooperative Gallery, and warm up with drinks and lunch at The Mine Cafe, a cozy eatery that does lots of great vegetarian and vegan dishes.

Explore the town's past at Jerome State Historic Park, a museum housed inside a 1916 mansion filled with displays about the surrounding underground mines and stories about the town's more scandalous aspects (bordellos, saloons, and gun fights- oh my!). If you want even more history, head to the Gold King Mine Museum and Ghost Town to stroll through a dizzying collection of antique trucks and old mining equipment.

Don't forget if you decide not to renew with us you need to bring us a 60 day notice to vacate in writing. We will miss you as residents and wish you good luck in the future.

Free Rent

Could you use some extra cash to help pay your rent next month? Just refer someone to live in your community and once they move in, we'll give you a referral fee toward your next month's rent. It's as simple as that. Referral fees may increase from time to time so contact the management office for the latest details.

Friendly Reminder

Quiet time hours are from 10:00pm to 8:00am daily. During this time we ask that you turn down the bass on your stereo, keep the volume on the stereos and TV's at a very low setting, keep conversations in your backyard to a whisper (sounds echo on the backyards).
