Requirements A: Resident Status

A vehicle will qualify for a resident permit if either of the following conditions are met:

- The vehicle is registered to an address in Provincetown and has a current motor vehicle excise bill issued through Provincetown.
- The owner/lessee of the vehicle can prove ownership of a property located in Provincetown.

Requirements B: Resident Senior

A vehicle will qualify for a resident senior permit if both of the following conditions are met:

- The vehicle fulfills the requirements listed previously for "Resident Status".
- The owner/lessee of the vehicle is 64 or older at the time of application.

Requirements C: Board/Committee Member

A vehicle will qualify for a board member permit if either of the following conditions are met:

- The owner/lessee of the vehicle is a Provincetown Firefighter or Rescue Squad member.
- The owner/lessee of the vehicle is on a Town Board or Committee as certified by the Town Clerk.
