MATERIALS

- Low water use plumbing fixtures
- Cabinets and trims made from composite wood that contain no urea-formaldehyde resins
- Carpeting and pad that has been part of the Carpet and Rug Institute Green Label Plus Program
- Energy Star Program:
 - Appliances
 - Lighting Fixtures
 - Water Heater
 - Mechanical Equipment
- Windows exceeding Energy Star performance requirements, with a U-factor and SHGC of ≤ 0.35 for the region
- Roof insulation containing more than 20% recycled material
- Finish materials with low emissions (radon gas, etc.) ratings such as paint, cabinets, carpet, linoleum, trim, tile, etc.
- SolaTubes® installed in hallways, lobby and kitchen for added “daylighting”

CONSTRUCTION HIGHLIGHTS

- Judicious use of locally supplied products (low energy impact to transport)
- Project is landscaped in Xeriscape. All plants are indigenous and after a brief period of watering (while they become established) will sustain themselves with local rainfall
