# Emegency Maintainence

If you notice there may be an issue in your unit, such as no hot water or no heat, please report as soon as you can so it can be addressed as early as possible.

Emergency situations (involving fire, flood or blood) can happen at any time. If at any point there is FIRE or BLOOD, please call 911 prior to calling emergency maintenance. If you experience a maintenance emergency after office hours, please call emergency maintenance at (630) 280-7454.

- No heat (when the inside temperature is 68 degrees or lower from 8:30am-10:30pm and 66 degrees or lower from 10:30pm-8:30am).
- No air conditioning (when the outside temperature is 88 degrees or higher AND your residence has reached 80 degrees or warmer).
- Electricity issues are taken on a case by case basis. If it's the entire BUILDING call ComEd directly and THEN notify the office so we can update our residents.
  - Uncontrollable water leak or flood. No water at all.
- Any life safety issue-broken/damaged patio door, broken/not locking main apartment door or broken/not locking patio door.
  - The toilet is clogged and not usable if you have only ONE toilet in your apartment home.
    - No hot water

Any/all other issues will be addressed on the next business day, in the order in which they were received. If you have an emergency after office hours, call emergency maintenance at (630) 280-7454.

When leaving a message, please leave your name, phone number, apartment number and the nature of the emergency. Please make sure to speak calmly, clearly and repeat your apartment number AND phone number TWICE so we can return your call correctly. Your call will be returned promptly.

## <u>Blue Cheese and</u> <u>Pear Tartlets</u>

Prep Time: 10 miles Cook Time: 15 mins Total Time: 25 mins

<u>Ingredients</u> <u>1 ripe pear - peeled, cored, and chopped</u> <u>4 ounces blue cheese, crumbled</u> <u>2 tablespoons light cream</u> <u>ground black pepper to taste</u> <u>1 (1.9 ounce) package mini phyllo tart shells</u>



#### <u>Directions</u>

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).

Mix together pear, blue cheese, and cream in a baking dish. Season with pepper. Spoon mixture into phyllo shells.

Bake in the preheated oven for 15 minutes. Serve warm.
