TORREY ROAD REPAVING PROJECT

BEGINS JULY 5, 2022

The City of Fenton and Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will begin resurfacing Torrey Road from the North Road roundabout to the Fenton City Limit starting July 5th. Project Highlights are listed:

- 0.99 miles of pavement rehabilitation. Pulverize, crush and shape the existing asphalt roadway with a new hot mix asphalt surface. Improvements include adding a passing flare at Georgetown Parkway, guardrail improvements at the S. Long Lake bridge, new sidewalk (east side of road) from North Road to Georgetown Parkway. The project includes street sign replacement and pavement markings.
- Contractor: Ace Saginaw Paving, Saginaw, Michigan
- Schedule: **Construction to start July 5th with re-open to traffic late October 2022.**
- Detour Route: The project area will be closed to thru traffic. Access to Georgetown Parkway and businesses in the construction area will be permitted. The posted detour route is **North Road to Lahring Road to Torrey Road and vice versa.**

I would like to emphasize the work zone will be posted "**Road Closed to Thru Traffic**" which minimizes traffic volume allowing the contractor to work in a timely, efficient manner. Motorists entering the work zone for local access to Georgetown Parkway and businesses within the work zone may experience minor delays during working hours. I encourage sharing the traffic control plan with your residents/customers/delivery vendors to clarify local access during construction.
