2 months before your move:

	Alert utility companies to disconnect services the day after you move and to have new service activated several days before you arrive at your new apartment.		Clean rugs and have them packed for moving.
			If necessary, arrange for storage at a near-by storage facility.
	If you're packing your place yourself, order supplies and start packing boxes.		Reserve the freight elevator at Vesty Park and confirm parking details.
1 v	week before your move:		
	Finish packing boxes.		Complete change-of-address forms at the post office, and send notices to magazine subscriptions, creditors, friends and relatives, alumni organizations, credit cards, banks, and any other necessary companies and organizations.
	Confirm travel arrangements, if needed.		
	Arrange payment or deposit for movers.		
	Get cash to have on hand to tip movers.		Notify your employers of your new contact
	Give directions to your new home for the moving company, confirm delivery date, and give the company your itinerary and cell phone number		information.

	Load your car with your first-night box and anything else you don't want on the moving truck. Make sure to move the car out of the way of the moving van.		Sign the bill of lading (ensure that the address and phone number are correct) and inventory, and keep your copies in a safe place.
	Accompany the mover as they inventory your possessions and makes condition reports.		Lock windows, turn off lights, close doors, and take a final tour of your home after the movers have finished to make certain nothing is left behind.
