Maintenance Reminders

If you encounter a maintenance issue, please submit a request through the portal as soon as it arises. The longer we wait to address the issue, the more likely it is to become a bigger problem. We've received several after-hours calls where residents have mentioned that the issue has been ongoing for days.

To ensure quicker resolution, please do not wait until after hours to inform us of a maintenance issue. The portal is available 24/7 and goes directly to our team, allowing us to address issues in the order they're received. If it's an emergency—such as no water, no hot water, no heat, no AC, or a water leak—please submit a work order and then call the office during business hours or the emergency line after hours. However, please do not wait for days or hours to report an issue.

Quiet Hours

We want everyone to enjoy their homes and live in a peaceful environment. However, being part of an apartment community can sometimes make that challenging, as you may hear, see, or smell things from your neighbors.

To maintain a respectful atmosphere, we ask residents to be mindful of their activities during our quiet hours, which are as follows:

- Sunday to Thursday: 10 PM to 8 AM
- Friday and Saturday: 11 PM to 9 AM
