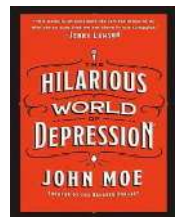

Dune: Part Two—Release date: March 1st

Cast: Timothée Chalamet, Zendaya, Rebecca Ferguson, Javier Bardem, Josh Brolin, Stellan Skarsgård, and Christopher Walken. The next chapter in Denis Villeneuve's epic adaptation of Frank Herbert's *Dune* continues with *Dune: Part Two*. We had expectations that the sequel to the Oscar-winning sci-fi movie would have premiered in 2023, but better late than never. With the likes of Austin Butler, Florence Pugh and Christopher Walken joining an already star-studded cast, this could be one of the biggest movies of the year.
