Did you know you can get items for your home for FREE from Self-Help at our Maintenance Facility located at 6601 Lutes.

Hours of Operation:

- Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.

Taking care of your HVAC

Your home's heating and cooling system (HVAC) is a critical component of making your home comfortable for your family. There are several things you can do to help ensure the system is running optimally:

- Set your fan to **Auto** mode—not the **On** mode. This will keep your home's relative humidity 10-15% lower because the auto mode will cycle longer.
- Changing the HVAC's filter once a month will keep it in tip-top shape, especially if you have pets. Plus, our team provides them for free! Visit our SELF-HELP at the Maintenance Facility located at 6601 Lutes to pick up a FREE replacement. We do recommend taking the old one or a picture of the old HVAC filter to ensure the proper size is given.
- Check your utility closet regularly for water intrusion or any potential issues. Please report to our maintenance team immediately if you notice any concerns.
- Keep windows and exterior doors closed when the air conditioning runs to prevent condensation from forming on air vents.
- Be careful not to block or restrict any heating, ventilation, or air conditioning ducts/vents.
- Mechanical closets (areas where the HVAC system equipment is located) should not be used for storage. Keep these areas clutter-free to avoid damage to the equipment and allow easy access for our team to perform system maintenance and repair tasks.
